

“Right to Work” is WRONG!

“Right to Work” is political overreach at its worst. Politicians shouldn’t interfere with agreements made between employers and their employees. Instead politicians should respect those agreements and focus on real priorities like creating good jobs and investing in education and infrastructure.



- States with so called “Right to Work” laws spend approximately \$3500 less per pupil on elementary and secondary education than other states, and students are less likely to be performing at their appropriate grade level in math and reading.
- Of the 10 states that spend the least on public education, 9 are “Right to Work” states.
- Of the 10 states with the least spending on public services, 8 are “Right to Work” states.
